ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR M.SC. COURSE (GEOINFORMATICS)

Indian Students

Intake: 60 students

Duration : Two Years Full Time

Reservations: Within the sanctioned intake

SC: 15%

ST: 7.5%

Differently abide : 3 3%

Over and above the sanctioned intake:-

Jammu and Kashmir Migrants : 2 seats per programme.

International Students including NRIs : 15%.

Eligibility:

Graduates in Engineering, IT, Computer Science, Science, Agriculture, Management, Geography and Commerce with a Minimum of 50% marks (45% marks for SC/ST candidates).

Final year students awaiting results may also apply.

Selection Procedure:

Through Writing Ability Test (WAT) and Personal Interview (PI).

Test schedule: Third or Fourth week of February in every Year.

Candidates will be called for Written Ability Test (WAT), Personal Interview (PI)

Final result of the WAT and PI will be intimated to candidates after 10 days of WAT PI through SIG website www.sig.ac.in

Application through online.

Candidate can also get register at the institute office by submitting application form at Institute office with Rs 750 Registration fee through demand draft on favor of Director, 'Symbiosis Institute of Geoinformatics' Payable at Pune .

Written Ability test is evaluate on the basis of innovative idea, knowledge of subject, fluency in writing, English grammar etc.The total time for WAT is 30 minute

Essential Documents for Confirmation of Admission:

All admissions are provisional and are subject to approval by the Symbiosis

International University. All students must ensure submission of one copy each of the following documents self-attested before PIWAT :-

- High school certificate
- Bachelor degree Statement of Marks.
- Post Graduation / Graduation Certificate.
- Migration Certificate.
- Caste Certificate issued by competent authority of respective state/ Central Government, if applicable.

Affidavit for change in name, if applicable.

Producing originals along with the attested copy for verification is mandatory.

Note: Candidates are personally responsible to ascertain whether they possess the requisite qualifications for admission. Having been admitted provisionally does not mean acceptance of eligibility. Final eligibility for admission will be decided by Symbiosis International University.

International Students:

The International Office of Symbiosis takes care of International Students aspiring for admission to the Institutes of Symbiosis International University.

To check if you are an international student, please refer to the categories listed below:

Categories under International Students Admissions:

Foreign National (FN): (At the undergraduate / Postgraduate Level):

A student is eligible to apply as a Foreign National (FN) if he/she holds a foreign passport.

Person of Indian Origin (PIO): (At the Undergraduate / Postgraduate Level):

A student is eligible to apply as a Person of Indian Origin (PIO) if he/she has a PIO card, and is a citizen of a country other than India.

Non Resident Indian (NRI):

(At the Undergraduate Level)

A student is eligible to apply as a Non Resident Indian (NRI) if he/she has appeared for the last qualifying exam (equivalent to Indian 10+2) outside India.

(At the Postgraduate Level)*

A student is eligible to apply as a Non Resident Indian (NRI) if he/she has appeared either for the 10+2 (equivalent to the Indian 10+2) examination or Graduation outside India. It is mandatory for one of the two qualifying examinations to be given outside India.
